



Judy Linn Membership Awards

The New England Chapter of the American Medical Writers Association (AMWA) established the Judy Linn Membership Awards in 2001 to provide professional development and networking support to medical and health communicators who are new to the field, with no more than three years of full-time experience. The chapter will accept applications from candidates who live and work in New England.

The award, a one-year membership in AMWA (which includes chapter membership), will be presented at a chapter dinner meeting. The recipient will be the chapter's guest at that meeting and will be given a framed certificate attesting to the award and coupons entitling him or her to attend three regular chapter meetings during the ensuing year at no charge. Designated chapter members will be available to guide the awardee during his or her first year as an AMWA member.

As many as three membership awards may be given in any period.

Candidates may apply on their own, or they may be nominated by a chapter member. Applications may be submitted at any time. The Membership Awards Committee will notify a candidate of its decision within two months of receipt of an application.
